R-2024-77

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under Act 101 Section 903 has provided funds for the reimbursement of 50% of the salary and eligible expenses of county recycling coordinator positions, and

WHEREAS, the County of Lawrence staffed this position funded through the Recycling/Solid Waste Budget, and

WHEREAS, the County of Lawrence, through the Department of Recycling/Solid Waste, is preparing the application for reimbursement for these expenses to be submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners that the Act 101 Section 903 Grant application for reimbursement of the salary and eligible expenses for 2023, for the county recycling coordinator, be submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.

RESOLUTION R-2024 -78

WHEREAS, the County of Lawrence entered into an agreement with Horizon Construction Group, Inc. to complete the Quaker Falls Recreation Area – Phase II in Mahoning Township under the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) Community Conservation Partnership Program (C2P2) grant program award number BRC-PRD-28-82; Resolution R-2023-485; and

WHEREAS, the original contract amount was for \$199,950.00; and

WHEREAS, the following changes are hereby made to the contract documents: this change order submission has been developed in conjunction with contract provisions, specifically a cost savings in the original bid award allowing for additional services to be provided; and

WHEREAS, specifically the inclusion of additional design and construction of two (2) sets of stairs and railing providing access to the lower falls viewing area; and

WHEREAS, it has been reviewed by R.A.R. Engineering Group, Inc. to approve Change Order #1 in the amount of \$68,800.00, for a total contract amount of \$268,750.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE BY THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, that:

- 1. Change Order #1 with Horizon Construction Group, Inc., an increase of \$68,800.00, shall be approved for the Quaker Falls Recreation Area Phase II in Mahoning Township, Lawerence County;

WHEREAS, the County of Lawrence has entered into an Alarm Monitoring Agreement with RID Security System, INC, DBA ProTech Security Systems (hereinafter the "CONTRACTOR" or "ProTech") with its principal address of 2201 E. Washington Street, New Castle, PA 16101.

WHEREAS, the County and ProTech have entered into an Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

WHEREAS, Protech agrees to provide monthly service of monitoring alarms at the following Tower sites: Spartan Park; Marr Road; Black Road; Army Corps; Jockey Moore Road; Pleasant Hill; New Castle Mercer Road; and Matilda Avenue. ProTech will provide these monthly services at the rate of Three Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars and Forty Cents (\$359.40) per tower site totaling Two Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$2,875.20) paid yearly. This Contract will not be construed to create a partnership, joint venture or employment relationship between ProTech and LAWRENCE. ProTech will not represent itself to be an employee or agent of LAWRENCE and cannot enter into any agreement on LAWRENCE's behalf or in LAWRENCE's name without express written authorization from a duly authorized representative of LAWRENCE to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that authorization is given to execute on behalf of the Lawrence County Department of Public Safety, all documents related to the ProTech Alarm Monitoring Agreement. ProTech will provide these monthly services at the rate of Three Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars and Forty Cents (\$359.40) per tower site totaling Two Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$2,875.20) paid yearly. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all documentation.

Innovative will not represent itself to be an employee or agent of LAWRENCE and cannot enter into any agreement on LAWRENCE's behalf or in LAWRENCE's name without express written authorization from a duly authorized representative of LAWRENCE to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that authorization is given to execute on behalf of the Lawrence County Department of Public Safety, all documents related to the Innovative Contract. Innovative will provide these monthly services at the rate of Three Thousand Five Hundred and Ninety-one (\$3,591.00) Dollars.
