Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of New Wilmington are required to recycle at their curb.

Each household has previously been issued a blue 95-gallon recycle tote. The recycle cart should be placed at the curb on Wednesday evening by 10:00 PM and please leave at least 2 feet between the refuse cart and the recycle cart.

Materials Collected:

- Glass food/beverage bottles and jars,
- Aluminum, steel, and tin cans
- Plastic bottles & jugs
- Corrugated cardboard
- Magazines
- Newspapers, including inserts
- Mixed office paper
- Junk mail

Please note that only bottles, jars, cans, and clean paper are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not include other items such as windows, toys, plastic bags, tubing, etc.

How: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: The current schedule can be found on the Borough's website. Recycle collection is currently every other week on Thursday.

Spring/Fall Cleanup: Yes, Spring.

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Yes, throughout the year through special arrangements with Tri-County Industries. Contact the borough office to arrange special pickups.

Electronics: Yes, collected curbside by appointment. See the instructions under Household Hazardous Waste to schedule an appointment.

Household Hazardous Waste/Chemicals: Yes, Collected curbside by appointment. Schedule an appointment by:
