 Boat Launch.
- CDBG and CDBG-CV1, CV2 and CV3: General administrative duties. Working
 with Grant Manager on FY2022 application changes. FY2023 allocations were
 received, and our application is due on October 27th. Applications for funding
 from non-entitlements are due on the 14th. The Ellwood City Street
 Improvement project has begun.
- ARPA: General Administrative Duties. Working with our auditor to approve possible projects and preparing agreements. Preparing quarterly report that is due on July 31st.
- SPC: Attended TTC meetings. Planning Directors Meeting. TIP Work groups have started and will be held monthly. .
