Whereas, the Lawrence County Register and Recorder's Office is entering into a Contract for Services with Gila LLC, a Texas limited liability company, d/b/a Municipal Services Bureau ("MSB). This Contract for Services is for the vendor to provide an online payment acceptance solution, including credit/debit card and E-check; and

Whereas, the Register and Recorder's Office is currently using AllPaid as their vendor for these services. However, the Register of Wills is implementing the ability to E-file estate documents and AllPaid does not provide an internet gateway for this process. Also, the fees to be paid by the customer to MSB will be 2.60%. AllPaid currently charges a fee of 2.95% to the customer and;

Whereas, there is no cost to the Register and Recorder's Office for this service. However, there is an initial charge for each terminal, and there will be three terminals purchased. The additional costs for these terminals will come out of the Records Improvement Fund and the Register of Wills Automation Fund and not from the General Fund and;

Whereas, the initial term of this Contract shall be for three (3) years and shall commence on the effective date. At the end of the initial term, the Contract shall automatically renew for additional two (2) year terms until terminated by either party; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; that:
