<b>Electronics</b> - TV's & Monitors	60 cents/pound
<b>Electronics</b> - All others (Towers, printers, microwaves, radios, VCRs, etc.)	40 cents/pound
<b>Household Hazardous Wastes</b> - All types	\$1.70/pound
<b>Batteries &amp; Fluorescent Lights</b> - All varieties	\$1.50/pound
<b>Propane Cylinders</b>	\$11 each

### APPLIANCES & TIRES (Payment is check/cash only. Registration IS NOT required)

Tri-County CleanWays will accept payment in the form of **CASH OR CHECK ONLY** for these items

<b>Appliances</b> - with Freon (refrigerators, air-conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.)	\$25 per item		
<b>Appliances</b> - All others (washers, hot-water tanks, stoves, etc.)	\$5 per item		
<b>Tires (Limit—20 Tires per Person)</b>			
- Passenger Vehicle:	\$3 per tire	- Light Truck:	\$5 per tire
- Tractor Trailer:	\$25 per tire	- Tractor Trailer on Rims:	\$40 per tire
- P/LT Tires on Rims:	\$10 per tire
