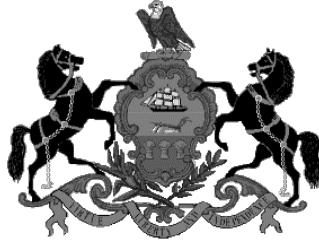

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – NEW CASTLE, PA, June 2023

The Lawrence County Treasurer, Richard L. Rapone would like to announce that Hunting licenses for the 2023-2024 season will go on sale on Monday, June 26, 2023, at 8:00 am. The Pennsylvania Game Commission has implemented some exciting changes that will affect our resident and non-resident hunters. A major change is, now, Antlerless tags can be purchased over the counter here at the Treasurer's office, as well as other additional agents that sell Hunting Licenses, the same day they go on sale, no mail-in application necessary. This means the use of the Pink Envelope has been eliminated by the Game Commission. Hunters may also go online at www.HuntFishpa.gov to purchase licenses. This will be a convenience to the Hunter, as now, they can get their Hunting licenses and Antlerless tag on the same day. The Antlerless License over-the-counter sales schedule will be as follows:

Round 1 (Personal Limit up to one)

Pennsylvania Residents, Monday, June 26th
Non-Resident License Buyers, Monday, July 10th

Round 2 (Personal Limit up to two)

Resident and Non-Resident License Buyers, Monday, July 24th

Round 3 (Personal Limit up to three)

Resident and Non-Resident License Buyers, Monday August 14th

Round 4 (Personal Limit up to six)

Resident and Non-Resident License Buyers, Monday August 28th

Please note, the Wildlife Management Unit (WMU) 2H has been dissolved and is now a part of WMU 2G. Landowner Licenses go on sale on Tuesday, June 20th. Another change is to the Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) permit. DMAP sales are starting later this year on Monday, August 14th.

The license fees are as follows:

Resident Adult License - \$20.97
Non-Resident - \$101.97
Senior Resident - \$13.97
Resident Antlerless Tag- \$6.97
Non-Resident Antlerless tag - \$26.97
