# NEW BUSINESS RESOLUTIONS

#### RESOLUTION R-2024-54

WHEREAS, the County of Lawrence is using a Grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development's Keystone Communities Program;

WHEREAS, the funds are to be used for the Ellwood City Façade Program;

**WHEREAS,** eligible applicants can apply and receive up to \$5,000 dollars towards Façade improvement;

**WHEREAS,** the County has received an application from the attached qualifying business owners and the Façade Steering Committee has reviewed and approved the applications for funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED** by the Lawrence County Board Commissioners that the Commissioners hereby enters into an agreement with the attached businesses for the Ellwood City Façade Grant.

#### **RESOLUTION R-2024-55**

**WHEREAS,** the County of Lawrence County owns and maintains recreational areas throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance of these recreational areas include, but not limited to ingress and egress to the park, a culvert replacement is needed to permit the public access to the facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Lawrence is requesting bids from contractors to complete the above mentioned items at the County owned recreational areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the County will advertise for bids on March 25, 2024 and March 29, 2024 with bids being due on April 15, 2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners that the Board of Commissioners will be advertising for bids for "West Park Road Culvert Replacement", with bids being due on April 15, 2024.

#### RESOLUTION R-2024-56

**WHEREAS**, County Ordinance No. 203 of 1996 titled *Increasing the Recording Fees of Deeds and Mortgages to Support and/or Enhance the County of Lawrence Local Affordable Housing Efforts* authorized the Recorder of Deeds to increase the fees charged for recording deeds and mortgages; and

**WHEREAS**, 85% of the additional revenue is set aside in a separate account to be used to fund affordable housing efforts in Lawrence County; and

**WHEREAS**, DON Enterprises, Inc. would like to start a program for a First Time Low-Moderate Homebuyer or Prospective Homeowner Closing Cost Grant Program for persons obtaining homes in Lawrence County; and

WHEREAS, these potential homeowners are often unable to obtain their first home due to insufficient funding for closing costs and a grant program of \$50,000.00 would greatly assist in fulfilling their home ownership dream; and

WHEREAS, DON Enterprises, Inc. staff will administer this program; and

WHEREAS, this program allows the administering organization a fee for these activities;

**WHEREAS,** DON Enterprises, Inc. intends to charge a \$200 administration fee per grant, e.g. approximately \$4,600.00 will be identified for the administration of the program and a total of approximately \$45,400.00 will be available for the approved participants of the program; and

WHEREAS, approximately 23 new homebuyers or prospective homeowners will benefit from the program and DON Enterprises, Inc. expects the funding will be expended within 24 months of its initiation and DON Enterprises, Inc. would be willing to accept the sum of \$50,000.00 to hold for eligible participants; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, that DON Enterprises will be allocated \$50,000.00 from the Affordable Housing fund to be used for the First-Time Low/Moderate Homebuyers or Prospective Homeowner Closing Cost Grant Program.

#### RESOLUTION R-2024-57
