Benefits:

Reimbursement:

Foster parents receive a daily reimbursement to cover room and board, food, clothing, and any allowance for any foster children placed in their care.

Incentives:

Our foster program offers a variety of fun incentives for foster parents and foster children to build a relationship.

Process:

Approval:

All foster homes are approved by Lawrence County Children and Youth Services in accordance with the State of Pennsylvania, Departments of Human Services, and Foster Care Regulations.

Evaluations:

The Foster Program Care Specialist will visit each foster home annually to insure that each foster home continues to meet the requirements of the State Foster Care Evaluations

Training: All foster parents are required to complete a minimum of 6 hours of approved training annually. The agency is required to provide this training in such areas as emergency medical first aid and approaches to child discipline.

WHO CAN BE A FOSTER PARENT?

Be single, married, divorced or in a partnership

Have children

Have a disability Rent or own your residence Have a modest income Be a working parent

FOSTER PARENT REQUIRMENTS

Be at least (21) years of age

Pass a medical appraisal by licensed physician

Pass screening requirements related to child abuse and criminal history clearances
