

UNION TOWNSHIP RECYCLING PROGRAM

Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of Union Township are required by state and local laws to recycle at their curb.

Contact Information: Your hauler. Contact Union Township for bins or other information—724-658-7921.

Materials Collected: Varies by hauler.

Tri-County Industries (724-658-8749):

- Aluminum, steel, and tin **cans**
- #1 & #2 plastic **bottles & jugs**
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Cardboard
- Junk Mail/Office paper

Waste Management (800-451-3060):

- Glass food and beverage **bottles** and **jars**
- Aluminum, steel, and tin **cans**
- #1 & #2 plastic **bottles & jugs**
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Cardboard
- Junk Mail/Office paper

Please note that only bottles, jars, and cans are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not include other items such as windows, toys, tubing, etc.

Businesses must also recycle, but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

How: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: Check with hauler for your schedule.

Spring/Fall Cleanup: Check with township.

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: No.

Leaf Waste: Yes, spring and fall. Drop-off available between.
Check with township for schedule.

Christmas Trees: Yes. Check with township for information.
