

LAWRENCE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD MEETING
PUBLIC MEETING
MINUTES OF Monday, May 31, 2022

The Lawrence County Election Board Meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag followed by a Moment of Silence.

The Lawrence County Election Board Meeting of Tuesday, May 31, 2022, was called to order by **Commissioner Morgan Boyd**, at 8:32 am at the Lawrence County Commissioners Meeting Room. Administrative Assistant, Kristine Venasco called the roll. Those in attendance were, **Commissioner Morgan Boyd, Commissioner Daniel Vogler, Commissioner Loretta Spielvogel, Tim Germani, Director of Voter/Election Services, Susan Kite, Deputy Director of Voter/Election Services, Carrie Hahn, Sheri Eldredge, and New Castle News, none.** It was stated for the record that the meeting is being taped. Those wishing to speak shall be given five minutes. If they need more time, they are to see the Deputy Chief Clerk at another time, and she will arrange for them to meet with the Commissioners. Those speaking are to state for the record their names, addresses and the nature of their business.

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENTS

Carrie Hahn stated that she has been investigating election integrity. She would like to know who paid for the drop boxes. She would like to review voter registration cards.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of Monday, May 16, 2022. Moved by Ms. Spielvogel, seconded by Mr. Vogler to accept and file the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

ELECTION DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Germani reported that there were 4,263 mail-in ballots and 335 of those went through the drop box. There were 1,128 Republican mail-in ballots and 3,135 Democrat mail -in ballots.

NEW BUSINESS

Moved by Ms. Spielvogel, seconded by Mr. Vogler to certify the results of the General Primary Election. Motion carried 3-0.

Ms. Spielvogel commended Mr. Germani on a job well done and thanked him. Mr. Vogler confirmed with Mr. Germani that the County is obligated to conduct a 2% audit. Mr. Germani reported that is correct. The audit was conducted and was spot on. He also stated that the recount must be completed by June 7 and the results must be reported by June 8th at noon. Mr. Vogler confirmed that the recount is only for the U.S. Senate Republican race which is mandated by the state.
